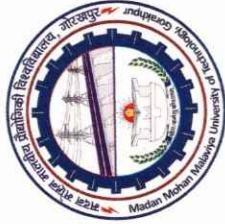

Prof. Dharendra Kumar Singh is born on June 7, 1963 in Lucknow, (UP). Dr Singh obtained his B.E. degree from MMMEC Gorakhpur in Mechanical Engineering in 1985, completed his M.E. from University of Roorkee (now IIT Roorkee) in 1997 and Ph.D. from Indian Institute of Technology Kanpur in 2006. Dr Singh joined MMMEC Gorakhpur on February 22, 1988 as lecturer and became Professor on January 1, 2008. He has visited Japan in 2003, USA in 2006, Lebia in 2006 for various academic and research works. Recently, He has participated foreign component training on “Leadership for advancing higher Education in India” during March 6-10, 2019 at Harvard Graduate School of Education, USA sponsored by MHRD New Delhi and Indian component training at IISER Kolkata (WB) during February 11-23, 2019. He is recipients of academic excellence award during alumni convention 2007, best R & D work in 2008 in M.M.M. Engineering College and citation for outstanding contribution for the growth of the University in August 2018.

To his credit, he has one patent on “A Method for Magnetic Abrasive Finishing using a Pulsating Flexible Magnetic Abrasive Brush and a Magnetic Abrasive Finishing Device” and has published 45 Research papers in peer reviewed International/National Journals and International/National Conferences. He also has organized/attended various conferences/workshops/seminars in various fields. He has supervised 14 M.Tech. Students and supervising 03 Ph.D. students. He has delivered invited talks in IITs/NITs/state engineering Colleges.

He held administrative post of Director, REC Azamgarh (2015-2018), Controller of Examinations, Dean Planning, QIP Coordinator, MBA Coordinator of MMMEC/MMMUT Gorakhpur. He is now serving as Dean of faculty affairs and second time as Head of the Mechanical Engineering Department of MMMUT Gorakhpur. He also has interactions with various research organizations in India and abroad. Recently he has been identified as an advisor for assisting UPSC, New Delhi. He is the Expert member of University Grant Commission, National Board of Accreditation, AICTE, UPPSC and member of Board of Management, MMMUT and other State Engineering Colleges in India
