As you are aware, Ministry of Human Resource Development (MHRD), Government of India, has launched the Prime Minister's Research Fellowship (PMRF) Program for direct admission to the Ph.D program at IISc, IISERs and IITs.

The PMRF selections for May 2019 is open for students who have completed or be pursuing the final year of four (or five) year undergraduate or five year integrated M.Tech or five year integrated M.Sc. or 2 year M.Sc. or five year undergraduate-postgraduate dual degree programs in Science and Technology streams from any Institute/University recognized in India. These candidates should have secured a CGPA/CPI of at least 8.0 (on a 10-point scale) or equivalent till the last semester and have secured a score of 750 or higher in the respective GATE subject.
