The university is in the eastern part of the city on Gorakhpur - Deoria road, about 9 Kilometers from Gorakhpur Railway Station as well as from main Gorakhpur Roadways bus-station. It is a fully residential technological University, with seven boys' hostels, four girls' hostels, and residences for faculty and staff.
