The minimum average annual financial turnover of the bidder during the last three years, ending on 31st March of the previous financial year, should be as indicated above in the bid document. Documentary evidence in the form of certified Audited Balance Sheets of relevant periods or a certificate from the Chartered Accountant / Cost Accountant indicating the turnover details for the relevant period shall be uploaded with the bid. In case the date of constitution / incorporation of the bidder is less than 3-year-old, the average turnover in respect of the completed financial years after the date of constitution shall be taken into account for this criteria.

2. Years of Past Experience required: The bidder must have experience for number of years as indicated above in bid document (ending month of March prior to the bid opening) of providing similar type of services to any Central / State Govt Organization / PSU. Copies of relevant contracts / orders to be uploaded along with bid in support of having provided services during each of the Financial year.

3. Estimated Bid Value indicated above is being declared solely for the purpose of guidance on EMD amount and for determining the Eligibility Criteria related to Turn Over, Past Performance and Project / Past Experience etc. This has no relevance or bearing on the price to be quoted by the bidders and is also not going to have any impact on bid participation. Also this is not going to be used as a criteria in determining reasonableness of quoted prices which would be determined by the buyer based on its own assessment of reasonableness and based on competitive prices received in Bid / RA process.

4. Past Experience of Similar Services: The bidder must have successfully executed/completed similar Services over the last three years i.e. the current financial year and the last three financial years(ending month of March prior to the bid opening): -

1. Three similar completed services costing not less than the amount equal to 40% (forty percent) of the estimated cost; or
2. Two similar completed services costing not less than the amount equal to 50% (fifty percent) of the estimated cost; or
3. One similar completed service costing not less than the amount equal to 80% (eighty percent) of the estimated cost.

5. Reverse Auction would be conducted amongst all the technically qualified bidders except the Highest quoting bidder. The technically qualified Highest Quoting bidder will not be allowed to participate in RA. However, H-1 will also be allowed to participate in RA in following cases:

- i. If number of technically qualified bidders are only 2 or 3.
- ii. If Buyer has chosen to split the bid amongst N sellers, and H1 bid is coming within N.
- iii. In case Primary product of only one OEM is left in contention for participation in RA on elimination of H-1.
- iv. If L-1 is non-MSE and H-1 is eligible MSE and H-1 price is coming within price band of 15% of Non-MSE L-1
- v. If L-1 is non-MII and H-1 is eligible MII and H-1 price is coming within price band of 20% of Non-MII L-1

OPTION CLAUSE 50% : The buyer can increase or decrease the contract quantity or contract duration up to 50 percent at the time of issue of the contract. However, once the contract is issued, the contract quantity or contract duration can only be increased up to 50 percent. Bidders are bound to accept the revised quantity or duration.

For lumpsum-based service contracts, the buyer may increase the scope of work and contract value up to 50 percent with the consent of the service provider

The Additional Terms and Conditions (ATC) have been incorporated by the Buyer after approval of their Competent Authority. The Buyer, is solely responsible for the impact of these clauses on the bidding process, its outcome, and consequences thereof including any restriction arising in the bidding process due to these ATCs and including the modification of technical specifications and / or terms and conditions governing the bid. All representations / grievances pertaining to the ATC clauses shall be raised with the buyer organization directly and not with GeM. If any of the clause(s) is/are incorporated by the Buyer regarding the following, the bid & resultant contract shall be treated as null & void. Further, GeM reserves the right, at its sole discretion, to cancel the bid forthwith, without issuance of any prior notice or intimation :-

1. Publishing Custom / BOQ bids for items for which regular GeM categories are available (unless such Custom / BOQ item is bunched with the major regular product Category Item).
2. Mandating procurement of / from specific Brand / Make / Model / Manufacturer / Dealer except in case of Single Bid / Proprietary Article Certificate (PAC) Buying.
3. Inclusion of disqualification criteria related to suspension of seller / service provider, where such suspension period has already expired.
4. Mandating submission of documents (other than EMD and signed Integrity Pact - which can be submitted within 5 days of bid opening) in physical form as a pre-requisite to qualify bidders.
5. Publishing bids on GeM for procurement of works.
6. Procurement of Goods by creating a Service bid on GeM & vice-versa.
7. Seeking sample with bid or approval of samples during bid evaluation process. However, trial / sample, as the case may be, shall be permitted in cases where trial / sample are allowed as per approved and published procurement policy of the Buyers' controlling Ministry / Department / State / Public Sector Enterprises Headquarters. If there is any violation of trial / sample clause with regard to approved policy of the Buyers' Ministry / Department / State / Public Sector Enterprises Headquarters, then this is to be determined and redressed by the concerned Buyer Organisation only.
8. Seeking experience from specific organization / department / institute only or from foreign / export experience.
9. Creating bid for items from incorrect categories.
10. Reference of conditions published on any external site or reference to external documents/clauses.
11. Asking for any Tender fee / Bid Participation fee, as the case may be.
12. Buyer added ATC Clauses which are in contravention of clauses defined in bid detail section, including specifications, EMD Detail, ePBG Detail and MII and MSE Purchase Preference sections of the bid, unless otherwise allowed by the applicable GeM GTC.
13. Any ATC clause in contravention with GeM GTC Clause 4 (xiii) (h) will be invalid. In case of multiple L1 bidders against a service bid, the buyer shall place the Contract by selection of a bidder amongst the L-1 bidders through a Random Algorithm executed by GeM system.
14. In a category based bid, adding additional items, through buyer added, additional scope of work/ additional terms and conditions/or any other document. If buyer needs more items along with the main item, the same must be added through bunching category based items or by bunching custom catalogues or bunching a BoQ with the main category based item, the same must not be done through ATC or Scope of Work.

Further, if any seller has any objection/grievance against these additional clauses or otherwise on any aspect of this bid, they can raise their representation against the same by using the Representation window provided in the bid details field in Seller dashboard after logging in as a seller. Buyer is duty bound to reply to all such representations and would not be allowed to open bids if he fails to reply to such representations.

All GeM Sellers/Service Providers shall ensure full compliance with all applicable labour laws, including the provisions, rules, schemes and guidelines under the four Labour Codes i.e. the Code on Wages, 2019; the Industrial Relations Code, 2020; the Occupational Safety, Health and Working Conditions Code, 2020; and the Code on Social Security, 2020 as and when notified and brought into force by the Government of India.

For all provisions of the Labour Codes that are pending operationalisation through rules, schemes or notifications, the corresponding provisions of the pre-existing labour enactments (such as The Minimum Wages Act, 1948, The Payment of Wages Act, 1936, The Payment of Bonus Act, 1965, The Equal Remuneration Act, 1976, The Payment of Gratuity Act, 1972, etc. and relevant State Rules) shall continue to remain applicable.

The Seller/ Service Providers shall, therefore, be responsible for ensuring compliance under:

- **All notified and enforceable provisions of the new Labour Codes as mentioned hereinabove; and**
- **All operative provisions of the erstwhile Labour Laws until their complete substitution.**

All obligations relating to wages, social security, safety, working conditions, industrial relations etc. and any other statutory requirements shall be strictly met by the Seller/ Service Provider. Any non-compliance shall constitute a breach of the contract and shall entitle the Buyer to take appropriate action in accordance with the contract and applicable law.

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I. BACKGROUND

Madan Mohan Malaviya University of Technology (MMMUT), Gorakhpur, Uttar Pradesh intends to implement 01 (One) SMART MOBILE MEDICAL UNIT (S-MMU) Services for providing accessible and affordable primary healthcare services to the general public across various villages and underserved areas of Gorakhpur.

MMMUT aims to strengthen community healthcare outreach by delivering preventive healthcare services, basic medical consultation, diagnostic support, health screening, and distribution of essential medicines directly at the doorstep of the public through fully equipped SMART MOBILE MEDICAL UNIT (S-MMU).

The proposed initiative is intended to improve healthcare accessibility, promote preventive healthcare practices, create public health awareness, and support early identification and management of common illnesses among the general public, particularly in rural, semi-urban, educational, labor-intensive, and underserved regions of Gorakhpur.

Under this initiative, the SMART MOBILE MEDICAL UNIT (S-MMU) shall provide:

- Basic medical health checkups;
- Doctor consultation and OPD services;
- Preventive healthcare and health screening services;
- Basic diagnostic investigations;
- Distribution of essential medicines;
- Healthcare counselling and awareness activities;
- Referral support services wherever required; and
- Community healthcare outreach programs.

Accordingly, MMMUT, Gorakhpur invites online bids through the Government e-Marketplace (GeM) Portal from eligible and experienced agencies for selection of an Agency for deployment, operation, management, and maintenance of SMART MOBILE MEDICAL UNIT (S-MMU) for providing healthcare services to the general public.

The selected Agency shall be responsible for deployment and operation of fully equipped S-MMU vehicles along with qualified medical and paramedical manpower, diagnostic infrastructure, medicines, consumables, IT-enabled reporting systems, GPS-enabled monitoring systems, and all allied operational requirements necessary for successful implementation of the project in accordance with the terms and conditions specified in this Tender Document.

The Agency shall ensure that:

- all deployed personnel possess valid educational qualifications and registrations;
- adequate substitute manpower is deployed during absence;
- manpower remains available during operational hours; and
- all staff maintain discipline, professional ethics, and proper conduct.

5. Patient Load, Operational Capacity and Responsibilities

The Agency and MMMUT shall each bear defined and separate obligations with respect to patient load under this Contract, as follows:

5.1 Agency Obligations

The selected Agency shall ensure that SMART MOBILE MEDICAL UNIT (S-MMU) is deployed at the designated location and fully operational on every scheduled working day. The Agency guarantees operational readiness for 50 patients per day across 25 working days per month per S-MMU, which shall include:

- (a) Deployment of the S-MMU vehicle at the designated location on time;

- (b) Presence of all prescribed qualified manpower — Medical Officer (MBBS), Staff Nurse / GNM, Pharmacist, Lab Technician, and Driver-cum-Support Staff;
- (c) Availability of all essential medicines, consumables, and diagnostic supplies sufficient to serve 50 patients;
- (d) Operational readiness of all diagnostic equipment and IT systems; and
- (e) Full delivery of all contracted healthcare services to every patient who presents themselves at the S-MMU on any given working day, without restriction on numbers.
- **(f) For ensuring adequate utilization of Mobile Health Unit services, selected service provider shall deploy 01 (one) community mobilizer for each Mobile Health Unit for operational/visit days and honorarium/remuneration of such community mobilizer shall be borne by service provider.**
- **(g) Community Mobilizer shall preferably be a local resident/worker of the area of deployment and shall be identified/deployed in consultation with MMMUT or its authorized representative to facilitate community participation, awareness generation, beneficiary mobilization and coordination with local stakeholders.**
- **(h) Service Provider shall maintain verifiable proof of deployment and actual visit of Smart Mobile Medical Unit at every scheduled location through GPS tracking, geo-tagged photographs, date and time stamped attendance records of deployed manpower, digital attendance (biometric wherever feasible). Such records shall form the basis for verification of service delivery and release of payment.**

Note: Mobile Health Unit shall provide healthcare services to 50 persons (only new cases shall be counted) during each visit to a village/location. Mobile Health Unit shall continue to visit a particular village/location until the target population is substantially covered and healthcare screening services are adequately saturated. Thereafter, Mobile Health Unit may be deployed to another village/location as identified by competent authority, while maintaining the service target of 50 persons (only new cases shall be counted) during each visit.

For the purpose of monitoring and reporting, new beneficiaries and follow-up beneficiaries shall be maintained as separate categories. Follow-up patients shall be medically examined, evaluated and provided necessary investigations, consultation and medicines, wherever clinically indicated. Follow-up patients shall not be counted towards the minimum daily target of new beneficiaries. No consultation fee, registration fee, physical examination fee or investigation charge shall be recovered from any beneficiary receiving services under this project.

Minimum operational requirement shall ordinarily be twenty-five (25) working days in a calendar month. In the event the number of available working days in any month falls below twenty-five (25) due to calendar configuration, Sundays may also be utilized for service delivery, if so directed by MMMUT, so as to ensure completion of prescribed minimum operational days.

In special circumstances, operations may be required on holidays as well. Failure to comply will result in the agency being warned and penalized.

5.2 MMMUT Obligations

Quality Control: Service Provider shall establish and maintain a documented Quality Assurance and Quality Control (QA/QC) System throughout the Contract Period. All medical equipment shall undergo preventive maintenance, calibration and validation at prescribed intervals and complete records thereof shall be maintained for inspection.

- healthy lifestyle awareness.

All awareness materials and vehicle branding shall be subject to approval of MMMUT, Gorakhpur.

11. Compliance Requirements

The selected Agency shall comply with:

The proposed Technology Partner / Software Integration Service Provider shall possess experience in implementation of Healthcare Information Systems (HIS), Electronic Medical Records (EMR), Electronic Health Records (EHR), Health Management Information Systems (HMIS), Telemedicine Platforms, Medical Device Integration Systems, Digital Health Platforms, or similar healthcare technology solutions.

The proposed Technology Partner shall possess:

1. General Instructions

Submission of a bid shall be deemed to have been made after careful study and examination of the Tender Document with full understanding of its implications.

Failure to furnish all information required under the Tender Document or submission of a bid not substantially responsive to the Tender requirements may result in rejection of the bid.

2. Eligibility of Bidders

The bidder participating in the Tender process shall:

- be a legally registered entity in India;
- possess valid statutory registrations;
- have experience in healthcare/mobile healthcare/medical service operations;
- possess adequate financial capability;
- comply with eligibility criteria prescribed in this Tender Document; and
- not be blacklisted by any Government department, PSU, autonomous body, or statutory authority.

3. Cost of Bidding

The bidder shall bear all costs associated with:

- preparation of bid;
- collection of information;
- site visits;
- participation in meetings/presentations;
- submission of documents; and
- any other expenses related to the Tender process.

MMMUT, Gorakhpur shall not be responsible for reimbursement of any such expenses irrespective of the outcome of the Tender process.

4. Clarification Regarding Tender Document

Any clarification regarding the Tender Document may be sought by the bidders within the prescribed timelines through the GeM Portal or official communication mechanism specified by MMMUT, Gorakhpur.

No request for clarification shall be entertained after the prescribed date.

The clarifications, corrigenda, amendments, or addenda issued by MMMUT, Gorakhpur shall form an integral part of this Tender Document.

5. Earnest Money Deposit (EMD)

The bidder shall furnish Earnest Money Deposit (EMD) as specified in the Tender Document / GeM Portal.

The EMD may be forfeited if:

- the bidder withdraws the bid during validity period;
- the bidder provides false information;
- the bidder refuses to accept Work Order/LOI;
- the bidder fails to furnish Performance Security; or
- the bidder violates Tender conditions.

6. Submission of Bids

The bids shall be submitted online only through the Government e-Marketplace (GeM) Portal within the prescribed timelines.

The Tender shall be processed through a Two-Bid System comprising:

Physical submission of bids shall not be accepted under any circumstances.

7. Separation of Technical and Financial Information

The bidder shall ensure that no financial information, price quotation, commercial offer, rate, cost details, or pricing information is disclosed in the Pre-Qualification-cum-Technical Bid.

Any disclosure of financial information in the Pre-Qualification-cum-Technical Bid may render the bid liable for rejection.

8. Documents to be Submitted

The bidder shall upload all required documents including:

MMMUT, Gorakhpur may, at its sole discretion, require bidders to provide technical presentations, demonstrations, operational briefings, proof of concept, or project implementation discussions for the purpose of assessing technical capability and project understanding.

The presentation shall not constitute a separate evaluation stage and marks shall be awarded only against pre-defined technical evaluation parameters.

All costs associated with such presentations shall be borne by the bidder.

10. Right to Accept or Reject Bid

MMMUT, Gorakhpur reserves the right to:

- accept or reject any bid;
- reject all bids;
- annul the Tender process;
- modify Tender conditions; or
- cancel the Tender process at any stage without assigning any reason.

No bidder shall have any claim against MMMUT, Gorakhpur on account of such decisions.

11. Confidentiality

The bidders shall maintain strict confidentiality regarding:

The bidders shall not disclose any information without prior written approval of MMMUT, Gorakhpur.

12. Fraudulent Practices

Any attempt by the bidder to influence the Tender process through:

- collusion;
- submission of forged documents;
- concealment of facts; or

- unethical means

shall result in immediate disqualification and may lead to legal action.

13. Consortium / Joint Venture

Consortium, Joint Venture, association of firms, or subcontracting arrangements shall not be permitted unless specifically approved in writing by MMMUT, Gorakhpur.

14. Performance Security

The successful bidder shall furnish Performance Bank Guarantee (PBG) in the prescribed format and value as specified in this Tender Document prior to execution of Agreement.

Failure to furnish Performance Security may result in cancellation of award and forfeiture of EMD.

15. Signing of Agreement

The successful bidder shall execute Agreement with MMMUT, Gorakhpur within the prescribed time period after issuance of Letter of Intent (LOI) / Work Order.

Failure to execute Agreement within stipulated time may result in cancellation of award.

16. Governing Law & Jurisdiction

The Tender process and Contract shall be governed by the laws applicable in India and the State of Uttar Pradesh.

The Courts situated in Gorakhpur shall have exclusive jurisdiction in matters arising out of this Tender and Contract.

XII. CRITERIA FOR EVALUATION

1. Evaluation of Bids

The bids submitted by the bidders shall be evaluated by the Tender Scrutiny Committee (TSC) / Evaluation Committee constituted by MMMUT, Gorakhpur in accordance with the provisions of this Tender Document and under the Least Cost Selection (LCS) methodology.

The evaluation process shall comprise the following stages:

1. Pre-Qualification-cum-Technical Evaluation;
2. Technical Qualification;
3. Financial Bid Evaluation; and
4. Final Selection under LCS Methodology.

The Tender shall be evaluated under Least Cost Selection (LCS) methodology. Technical Evaluation shall be carried out first. Only bidders securing minimum 75 marks out of 100 and satisfying all eligibility criteria shall be declared technically qualified. Financial bids of only technically qualified bidders shall be opened on GeM Portal. The bidder quoting the lowest evaluated financial bid (L1) shall be considered for award of contract. Technical marks shall be used only for determining technical qualification and shall not carry any weightage in financial ranking or final selection.

MMMUT, Gorakhpur reserves the right to verify the authenticity, correctness, validity, and completeness of all documents, certificates, declarations, financial statements, experience credentials, and other information submitted by the bidders at any stage of the Tender process.

The Technical Evaluation shall be used only for determining technical responsiveness and qualification of bidders and shall not carry any financial weightage, score normalization, composite score calculation, or ranking formula for award of the Contract.

In case two or more bidders quote the same Lowest Evaluated Financial Bid (L1), preference shall be given in the following order:

- Bidder securing higher Technical Evaluation Marks;
- Bidder having higher Average Annual Turnover during the last three financial years;

The decision of MMMUT, Gorakhpur regarding responsiveness of bids, qualification of bidders, financial evaluation, determination of L1 bidder, and award of Contract shall be final and binding on all bidders.

XII. APPOINTMENT OF SERVICE PROVIDER

MMMUT, Gorakhpur shall award the Contract to the bidder whose bid is found substantially responsive to the requirements of this Tender Document, who satisfies the Pre-Qualification Criteria, secures the minimum qualifying marks prescribed under the Technical Evaluation Criteria, and quotes the Lowest Evaluated Financial Bid (L1) under the Least Cost Selection (LCS) methodology specified in this Tender Document.

The bidder quoting the Lowest Evaluated Financial Bid (L1) among the Technically Qualified Bidders shall be considered as the Successful Bidder for award of the Contract.

Upon completion of the evaluation process and approval of the competent authority, MMMUT, Gorakhpur shall issue a Letter of Intent (LOI) to the Successful Bidder.

The Successful Bidder shall submit the Letter of Acceptance (LOA), duly signed and stamped by the Authorized Signatory, within Ten (10) Days from the date of receipt of the Letter of Intent (LOI) as confirmation of acceptance of the terms and conditions of the Tender.

In the event the Successful Bidder fails to submit the Letter of Acceptance (LOA) within the prescribed period, MMMUT, Gorakhpur reserves the right to cancel the award of Contract, forfeit the Earnest Money Deposit (EMD), and proceed in accordance with the provisions of this Tender Document.

The Successful Bidder shall submit the Performance Bank Guarantee (PBG) within Fifteen (15) Days from the date of submission of the LOA in the format and amount prescribed under this Tender Document.

Failure to submit the Performance Bank Guarantee within the stipulated period may result in cancellation of the award, forfeiture of EMD, and such other action as may be deemed appropriate by MMMUT, Gorakhpur.

Upon submission and acceptance of the Performance Bank Guarantee and fulfillment of all pre-contract requirements, MMMUT, Gorakhpur shall execute a formal Agreement with the Successful Bidder within Ten (10) Days.

The Agreement shall incorporate the provisions of:

- this Tender Document;
- Corrigenda and Addenda issued thereto;
- Letter of Intent (LOI);
- Letter of Acceptance (LOA);
- Work Order;
- Scope of Work;
- Service Level Requirements; and
- other documents forming part of the Contract.

Upon execution of the Agreement, MMMUT, Gorakhpur shall issue the Work Order and/or Notice to Proceed (NTP) authorizing commencement of SMART MOBILE MEDICAL UNIT (S-MMU) Services.

The Service Provider shall commence deployment and operationalization of SMART MOBILE MEDICAL UNIT (S-MMU) Services **within 60 days** and shall ensure readiness of manpower, vehicles, medical equipment, medicines, consumables, IT systems, GPS systems, and all operational infrastructure necessary for commencement of services.

The Contract shall remain valid for an initial lock-in period of one (01) Year from the date of commencement of services or issuance of the Work Order, whichever is later.

The contract may thereafter be extended for a further period of two (02) years, on a year-to-year basis, subject to the satisfactory performance, compliance with Contract requirements, achievement of service levels, and operational requirements of MMMUT, Gorakhpur by agency/service provider.

The performance of the agency/service provider shall be evaluated at the end of each contract year by a Committee constituted by the Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor, Madan Mohan Malaviya University of Technology (MMMUT), Gorakhpur. Any extension of the contract shall be subject to the recommendations of the said Committee and approval of the Competent Authority.

Note: The Agreement shall remain valid for three years. However, continuation beyond each contract year shall be subject to annual performance review and satisfactory service delivery.

The Service Provider shall provide healthcare consultation, preventive healthcare services, health screening, diagnostics, medicine distribution, referral support services, awareness activities, and all other services forming part of the Scope of Work throughout the Contract Period in accordance with the provisions of this Tender Document and directions issued by MMMUT, Gorakhpur from time to time.

XIII. PAYMENT TERMS

The payment under this Tender shall be made by MMMUT, Gorakhpur on monthly basis to the selected Service Provider for successful deployment, operation, management, and execution of SMART MOBILE MEDICAL UNIT (S-MMU) Services in accordance with the terms and conditions specified in this Tender Document.

The estimated project cost under this Tender shall be Rs. 9,00,000/- (Rupees Nine Lakhs Only) per SMART MOBILE MEDICAL UNIT (S-MMU) per Month for the first year.

The above amount shall be inclusive of all costs relating to:

- deployment and operation of S-MMU vehicle;
- medical and para-medical manpower;
- medicines and consumables;
- diagnostic services;
- fuel and maintenance;
- insurance and statutory compliances;
- GPS and reporting systems;
- awareness and IEC activities; and
- all operational and administrative expenses required for execution of the project.

A fixed annual escalation of Two Percent (2%) compounded annually shall be applicable from Year 2 onwards, calculated on the anniversary of the date of commencement of services, as per the predetermined escalation schedule specified in Clause 13 — Price Variation and Annual Escalation of this Tender Document. Escalation shall be applicable only upon satisfactory annual performance evaluation and certification by MMMUT.

The Service Provider shall submit monthly invoices along with supporting documents, operational reports, attendance records, GPS movement records, beneficiary reports, medicine utilization details, and other documents as may be required by MMMUT, Gorakhpur.

The payment shall be released on monthly basis subject to:

- satisfactory performance of services;
- submission of required reports and documents;
- verification of service delivery; and
- certification by the designated authority of MMMUT, Gorakhpur.

MMMUT, Gorakhpur reserves the right to withhold, deduct, or recover payments in case of:

- non-performance or partial performance of services;
- non-deployment of required manpower;
- interruption or deficiency in services;
- non-submission of reports and records;
- violation of Tender conditions; or

- any operational lapses observed during inspection or monitoring.

All payments shall be made through electronic transfer to the bank account of the Service Provider after deduction of applicable taxes, statutory deductions, penalties, recoveries, and other dues as applicable under law.

The Service Provider shall be solely responsible for payment of salaries, wages, EPF, ESI, insurance, taxes, statutory dues, and all liabilities relating to the personnel deployed under the project.

MMMUT, Gorakhpur shall not be responsible for any employment-related liability, compensation, insurance, statutory payment, or other obligations of the manpower engaged by the Service Provider.

In case of any dispute relating to invoice processing or payment, the decision of MMMUT, Gorakhpur shall be final and binding on the Service Provider.

Penalty clause / liquidated damages.

In case of delay in commencement of services, interruption of services, non-performance, manpower shortage, non-deployment of S-MMU, or failure to fulfill contractual obligations, MMMUT, Gorakhpur may impose penalty / liquidated damages.

The Service Provider shall ensure deployment of the designated SMART MOBILE MEDICAL UNIT (S-MMU), medical equipment, and requisite manpower strictly in accordance with the deployment schedule, approved route plan, operational requirements, and instructions issued by MMMUT from time to time.

In the event that the Service Provider fails to deploy the designated S-MMU vehicle, required manpower, medical personnel, or supporting infrastructure on any scheduled day, route, or location approved by MMMUT, without prior written approval or valid justification acceptable to MMMUT, MMMUT shall have the right to impose an operational penalty equivalent to 4% of the monthly billing value for the relevant month.

Actual patient footfall shall be recorded and reported by the Agency and MMMUT on a daily and monthly basis. If the patient footfall is less than 70% of the monthly target screenings, a payment deduction or penalty will be imposed on the service provider equivalent to 5% of the monthly billing value for the relevant month.

Where no specific penalty is prescribed for a particular SLA parameter, a penalty equivalent to 1% of the monthly billing value for each percentage point shortfall in SLA achievement may be imposed, subject to a maximum of 5% of the monthly billing value for the relevant month.

The decision of MMMUT regarding determination of the default, assessment of service deficiency and quantum of penalty shall be final and binding upon the Service Provider.

The Successful Bidder/Service Provider shall comply with all Service Levels specified in the Contract and the corresponding Service Level Agreement (SLA). Performance shall be measured on a monthly basis unless otherwise specified in the Contract.

XIV. GENERAL CONDITIONS OF CONTRACT

1. Communication

All notices, approvals, instructions, communications, and correspondence relating to this Tender and Contract shall be made in writing and may be communicated through hand delivery, registered post, courier, official e-mail, or any other approved electronic mode of communication.

The address and e-mail details furnished by the bidder in the Tender shall be treated as the official address for all communications unless changed through written notice to MMMUT, Gorakhpur.

2. Earnest Money Deposit (EMD) / Bid Security

The bidder shall furnish Earnest Money Deposit (EMD) / Bid Security of the amount specified in the Tender Document through the mode prescribed in the GeM Portal.

The EMD of unsuccessful bidders shall be refunded in accordance with applicable rules and procedures. The EMD of the successful bidder may be adjusted or released after submission of the Performance Bank Guarantee (PBG).

MMMUT, Gorakhpur reserves the right to forfeit the EMD in case of:

- withdrawal of bid during validity period;
- submission of false information;
- refusal to accept LOI / Work Order; or
- failure to comply with Tender conditions.

3. Performance Bank Guarantee (PBG)

The successful bidder shall submit a Performance Bank Guarantee (PBG) equivalent to Five Percent (5%) of the total Contract Value in the prescribed format from a Nationalized Bank / Scheduled Bank.

The PBG shall be submitted within Fifteen (15) days from the date of submission of the Letter of Acceptance (LOA) and shall remain valid up to Sixty (60) days beyond completion of the Contract Period.

MMMUT, Gorakhpur reserves the right to invoke the PBG in case of breach of Contract, non-performance, violation of Tender conditions, or failure to comply with statutory obligations.

The PBG shall be released after satisfactory completion of all contractual obligations.

4. Data Privacy, Information Security and Patient Confidentiality

1. The Service Provider shall maintain strict confidentiality of all patient information, medical records, diagnostic reports, beneficiary details, personal information, health data, electronic records, and any other information collected, generated, processed, stored, transmitted, or accessed during execution of the Contract.
2. All patient data, medical records, beneficiary information, reports, databases, software-generated information, analytics, and related records created under this Project shall remain the sole property of MMMUT, Gorakhpur and/or the concerned Government Authority, as applicable.

3. The Service Provider shall not disclose, publish, transfer, share, sell, reproduce, copy, distribute, or permit access to any patient information or project-related data to any third party without prior written approval of MMMUT, except where required under applicable law or Government directions.
4. The Service Provider shall implement appropriate administrative, technical, physical, and cybersecurity safeguards to protect patient information against unauthorized access, disclosure, alteration, destruction, loss, theft, cyberattack, malware, ransomware, data breach, or misuse.
5. All electronic medical records, digital health records, diagnostic reports, and beneficiary databases shall be maintained through secure systems with role-based access control, user authentication, audit trails, password protection, encryption, and backup mechanisms.
6. Wherever applicable, the Service Provider shall ensure compliance with the provisions of the Digital Personal Data Protection Act, 2023, Ayushman Bharat Digital Mission (ABDM) guidelines, applicable Government of India digital health policies, and other relevant laws and regulations.
7. Access to patient information shall be restricted only to authorized personnel directly involved in service delivery and project management on a need-to-know basis.
8. The Service Provider shall ensure that all deployed personnel execute confidentiality and non-disclosure undertakings prior to commencement of duties under the Project.
9. Any actual, suspected, or potential data breach, cybersecurity incident, unauthorized disclosure, loss of records, or compromise of patient information shall be reported to MMMUT within twenty-four (24) hours of its detection, along with details of corrective and preventive measures taken.
10. MMMUT, Gorakhpur or its authorized representatives shall have the right to conduct audits, inspections, vulnerability assessments, security reviews, and compliance verification of systems and processes relating to data protection and information security.
11. Upon expiry or termination of the Contract, the Service Provider shall immediately hand over all physical and electronic records to MMMUT and shall permanently delete or destroy all copies of patient data in its possession, except where retention is required by law, and shall furnish a certificate of data destruction if so required by MMMUT.
12. Any breach of patient confidentiality, unauthorized disclosure of information, or violation of data protection obligations shall be treated as a material breach of the Contract and may result in imposition of penalties, recovery of damages, termination of the Contract, forfeiture of Performance Security, blacklisting, and initiation of legal proceedings.
13. The obligations relating to confidentiality, data protection, and information security shall survive expiry or termination of the Contract.

5. Arbitration and Jurisdiction

This Tender and the Contract Agreement shall be governed by the laws of India and the applicable laws of the State of Uttar Pradesh.

Any dispute/arbitration shall be resolved amicably between service provider and MMMUT. Failing such resolution, the dispute/arbitration shall be referred to a sole arbitrator appointed by Hon'ble Vice Chancellor of MMMUT, Gorakhpur

The Courts situated in Gorakhpur shall have exclusive jurisdiction in matters arising out of this Tender and Contract.

6. Dispute Resolution

In case of any dispute arising out of this Tender or Contract, the matter shall first be referred to MMMUT, Gorakhpur for amicable resolution.

If the dispute is not resolved, the matter shall be subject to the jurisdiction of the competent courts in Gorakhpur

During the pendency of any dispute, the Service Provider shall continue execution of services without interruption.

7. Force Majeure

Neither party shall be liable for delay or failure in performance of obligations due to events beyond reasonable control including natural calamities, floods, fire, war, riots, epidemics, pandemics, governmental restrictions, or other Force Majeure events.

The affected party shall inform the other party in writing within Seven (7) days from occurrence of such event.

If the Force Majeure condition continues for more than Sixty (60) days, MMMUT, Gorakhpur shall have the right to terminate the Contract without any financial liability except for services satisfactorily completed.

8. Permits, Licenses and Statutory Compliance

The Service Provider shall obtain and maintain all necessary registrations, licenses, permits, approvals, and statutory compliances required under applicable laws for execution of services under this Tender.

The Service Provider shall be solely responsible for payment of all taxes, duties, GST, EPF, ESI, insurance liabilities, labour dues, and statutory obligations.

9. Biomedical Waste and Environmental Compliance

The Service Provider shall comply with all applicable Biomedical Waste Management Rules, Pollution Control Board norms, environmental regulations, and healthcare waste disposal standards during execution of the services.

The Service Provider shall ensure safe handling and disposal of biomedical waste generated through operation of SMART MOBILE MEDICAL UNIT (S-MMU) Services.

10. Statutory Deductions and Taxes

All applicable statutory deductions including Income Tax (TDS), GST-TDS, and other deductions as applicable under law shall be deducted from payments payable to the Service Provider.

Necessary certificates relating to such deductions shall be issued by MMMUT, Gorakhpur as per applicable law.

11. Extension of Time

The Service Provider may request extension of time for performance of obligations by submitting a written request with proper justification before expiry of the stipulated timeline.

Grant of extension shall be at the sole discretion of MMMUT, Gorakhpur and shall not automatically entitle the Service Provider to additional financial compensation.

12. Deficiency in Services

In case of deficiency in services, non-performance, interruption of services, non-deployment of manpower, non-availability of medicines/equipment, or violation of Tender conditions, MMMUT, Gorakhpur shall have the right to issue notice to the Service Provider for rectification within the prescribed timeline.

Failure to rectify the deficiencies may result in deduction of payments, imposition of penalties, suspension of services, termination of Contract, or forfeiture of PBG.

13. Price Variation and Annual Escalation

The estimated rate for the First Year (Year 1) of the Contract shall be Rs. 9,00,000/- (Rupees Nine Lakhs Only) (which is indicative and actual cost depends on L1 rate) per SMART MOBILE MEDICAL UNIT (S-MMU) per Month, inclusive of all costs, taxes, duties, and operational expenses.

A fixed annual escalation of Two Percent (2%) compounded annually shall be applicable from Year 2 onwards over the immediately preceding year's approved rate, calculated on the anniversary of the date of commencement of services. The predetermined rates for the entire Contract Period are as follows:

The above escalation rates are fixed and predetermined for the entire Contract Period of One (01) Year and shall not be subject to further revision, negotiation, or indexation to any external index including the Wholesale Price Index (WPI) or Consumer Price Index (CPI). No additional price escalation or variation shall be allowed under any circumstances unless specifically approved in writing by MMMUT, Gorakhpur. The above data is tentative and actual calculation shall be calculated on basis L1 financial offer/contract value per month.

14. Risk and Cost

If the Service Provider fails to perform the services or abandons the work during the Contract Period, MMMUT, Gorakhpur shall have the right to make alternative arrangements at the risk and cost of the Service Provider.

Any additional expenditure incurred by MMMUT, Gorakhpur shall be recoverable from the pending bills, Security Deposit, or Performance Bank Guarantee of the Service Provider.

15. Termination of Contract

MMMUT, Gorakhpur reserves the right to terminate the Contract wholly or partially by issuing written notice in case of breach of Tender conditions, non-performance, submission of false information, insolvency, abandonment of services, fraudulent practices, or violation of statutory obligations.

MMMUT, Gorakhpur may also terminate the Contract in public interest or administrative necessity without assigning any reason.

MMMUT may terminate the contract by giving 90 days written notice if:

- Service levels are not achieved.
- Repeated penalties are imposed.
- Fraud or misrepresentation is detected.
- Statutory compliances are violated.
- Insolvency or liquidation proceedings commence.
- Patient safety is compromised.

MMMUT may terminate immediately for:

- Submission of forged documents.
- Corruption or bribery.
- Data breach involving patient information.
- Blacklisting by Government authority.

Upon termination, the Service Provider shall immediately discontinue services and hand over all records, reports, and project-related documents to MMMUT, Gorakhpur.

16. Indemnity

The Service Provider shall indemnify and keep indemnified MMMUT, Gorakhpur, its officers, employees, and representatives against all claims, losses, damages, liabilities, penalties, costs, and expenses arising out of:

- breach of Contract;
- negligence;
- deficiency in services;
- violation of statutory provisions;
- acts or omissions of deployed personnel;

- medical negligence; or
- third-party claims.

17. Insurance

The Service Provider shall obtain and maintain adequate insurance coverage for vehicles, manpower, medical equipment, healthcare professionals, accidents, and third-party liabilities during the Contract Period.

MMMUT, Gorakhpur shall not be liable for any injury, accident, damage, loss, or compensation arising during execution of the Contract.

18. Inspection, Monitoring and Audit

MMMUT, Gorakhpur or its authorized representatives shall have the right to inspect, monitor, verify, and audit the functioning of SMART MOBILE MEDICAL UNIT (S-MMU) Services, manpower deployment, records, medicines, equipment, vehicles, and operational activities at any time during the Contract Period.

The Service Provider shall provide full cooperation and access during such inspections and audits.

19. Compliance with Applicable Laws

The Service Provider shall comply with all applicable Central Government and State Government laws, rules, regulations, healthcare standards, labour laws, biomedical waste management rules, motor vehicle laws, and statutory requirements applicable to execution of services under this Tender.

Any violation of applicable laws by the Service Provider shall be solely attributable to the Service Provider and MMMUT, Gorakhpur shall stand indemnified against all consequences arising therefrom.

20. 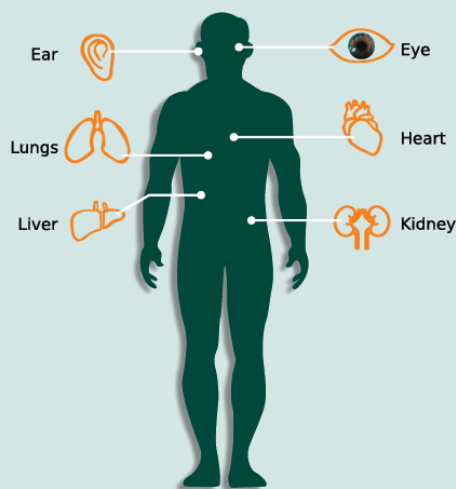

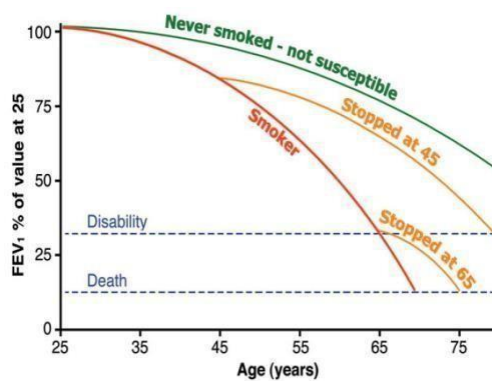
