GUIDELINES FOR SOCIAL INTERNSHIP 2026

- All second-year (2025–26) lateral entry students are required to compulsorily fill out the Social Internship Google Form released by the NSS Cell, MMMUT. The link is provided below.
- G-Form Link for Social Internship Registration:
<https://forms.gle/nUp6JW8MfexJfhgc8>
- No educational institute (e.g., college, government school, NSS cells in other colleges) should be involved. The internship must be undertaken only under government registered NGOs with a valid Darpan ID.
- The internship process must not involve any kind of fundraising; it should be carried out voluntarily.
- There should be no entry fees or any kind of certification fees involved during the entire process.
- No stipend should be accepted by any student during the entire course of the internship. It is a social internship and must be completed voluntarily.
- If any government-registered NGO asks for a letter of recommendation stating your details, you may contact the official email ID nss@mmm.ut.ac.in, and the same will be provided. (Only if the NGO specifically requests it; most NGOs will accept the notice issued by the Office of the Dean of Extension Field Outreach and Alumni Relations).
- After completion of the internship, the student must receive a valid and verified certificate from the NGO containing an official seal and Darpan ID clearly stating that the work duration was two weeks (10 days, 8 hours daily).
- The proof of completion must clearly include the student's name, roll number and branch.
- A proper day-wise report must be maintained on the basis of 10 days (approximately 80 hours), including details of the work done along with geotag photos and videos. The student will be required to present this during the evaluation.
- Any internship that involves only remote work will not be considered and will be graded as unsatisfactory.

Note: Violation of any of the above-mentioned guidelines will result in unsatisfactory grade
