MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (MOU)

BETWEEN

INDIAN INSTITUTE OF INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY, ALLAHABAD

AND

MADAN MOHAN MALAVIYA UNIVERSITY OF TECHNOLOGY, GORAKHPUR

This MOU is entered into on the day of July, 2018 by and between Indian Institute of Information Technology, Allahabad, U. P. (hereinafter called IIITA) situated at Allahabad (U.P.), India, an Institute of National Importance established by special act of Parliament of Republic of India,

And

Madan Mohan Malaviya University of Technology, Gorakhpur (hereinafter called MMMUT¹), situated at Gorakhpur (U.P.), an University of State Government by act of U.P. State Government.

The aforesaid organizations are hereinafter referred to individually as *Institute/University* and collectively as *institutions*.

1. Objectives of the MOU

The objectives of the MOU are:

a) Development of joint education programmes.

- b) Hosting the faculty members and students by IIIT Allahabad for mutually agreed duration and terms and conditions.
- c) Joint thesis supervision, research, projects, publications, and patents etc.

d) Promoting collaboration in various academic activities.

- e) To encourage bright students of MMMUT to come for higher education and internship at IIITA against credit transfer.
- f) Helping in increasing the placement of students and consultancy projects.

2. Technical Areas of Collaboration

a) To implement a Continuing Education Programme to improve quality of teaching and technical staffs of participating establishment through short-term/long-term certificate courses at IIITA with or without credits. Faculty members of IIITA could also be sent to participating establishment for necessary guidance.

b) To provide academic interaction by delivering Special Lectures at participating establishment on topics of relevance to modern industry, start-up, skill India, digital India, community development, etc.

c) Organizing joint workshops/conferences and Personality/Professional Development


Programmes for enhancement of skills to Faculty, Staff and Students.

d) To provide necessary support for establishment of Video satellite link and assistance in development of E-class rooms, Lab, Curriculum, establishment of research Labs, Training and Placement and Library etc. at participating establishment.

e) Usage of academic infrastructure of IIITA for participating establishment students and

faculty members.

- f) To facilitate the training for teachers and postgraduate students of participating establishment.
- g) Guidance for enhancement in infrastructural development of participating establishment.
- h) Joint supervision of M. Tech. and Ph. D. theses as per IIITA/ participating establishment norms.
- i) Doing the joint International and National sponsored/consultancy projects.



3. Terms and Conditions

 a) The cost of development of infrastructure at participating establishment should be borne by participating establishment only.

b) For continuing education to participating establishment teachers and students, the

financial arrangements will be made on mutually agreed terms and conditions.

c) For the visits related to advice and consultancy, travel and other expenses of IIITA Faculty and Staff shall be reimbursed on mutually agreed terms.

d) The faculty members and students of participating establishment can use the library

facility of IIITA for short-time free of cost.

e) Usage of IIITA academic infrastructure can be allowed for limited period subject to its availability, approval of Head of the facility/department as per Institutions norms.

f) Both institutions agree to help, identify and invite the faculty members and researchers from the other institution to participate in conferences/seminars/symposia, workshops and short-term courses.

g) This MOU may be amended, renewed and terminated by mutual written agreement of the institutions at any time.

h) Either *Institution* shall have the right to terminate this MOU upon 60 days prior written notice to the other *Institution*.

4. Confidentiality

a) The IIITA and the participating establishment agree to hold in confidence all information/data designated by the *institutions* as being confidential which is obtained from either *institute* or created during the performance of the MOU and will not disclose the same to any third party without written consent of the other *institution*.

b) The above confidential clause under this MOU excludes the information/data possessed by either *institution* before entering into this MOU or independently developed and/or information already available through public domain.

5. Duration of MOU

This MOU, unless extended by mutual written consent of the *institutions*, shall expire in FIVE years after the effective date specified in the opening paragraph. However, on review, the MOU shall be extended for another TWO years by mutual consent.

6. Coordinators

Both Institutions will designate persons who will have responsibility for co-ordination and implementation of this agreement.

7. Intellectual Property Rights

The intellectual property rights (IPR) that arise as a result of joint research and collaborative activity under the agreement will be worked out on a case to case basis and will be consistent with officially laid down IPR policies of the two institutions.

8. Signed in Duplicate

This MOU is executed in duplicate with each copy being an official version and having equal legal validity. By signing below, the *institutions*, acting by their duly authorized officers, have caused this Memorandum of Understanding to be executed, effective as of the day and year first above written.
